Health and Safety Rules for Golfers

Please do not commence or continue your round if visibility drops below 100 yards. In the event of thunder and/or lightning please return to the clubhouse or your car immediately.

Priority must be given to members of the public, whether on foot or in vehicles, who are using permitted rights of way on the course. Please do not play your shot until they are out of range.

Please give way to greenkeeping staff at all times. They are aware of you and will let you play your shot safely as soon as reasonably possible.

Be aware of other golfers within range. If in doubt do not play. Please do not play your shot from the 9th / 18th tees unless the 4th green is clear

Please be aware of other golfers who may be in range but out of sight. Please ring the bell as you leave the 3rd/12th green to make others aware of your presence.

If in doubt shout 'Fore'

Be aware of deep water. Look for the signs

Be aware that paths and bridges may become slippery in wet weather

Buggy Users: Please be aware that the 9th/18th fairways slope steeply and have many protruding large stones. Please drive slowly, no more quickly than walking pace.

Adders: Our heathland course is the perfect habitat for the adder. They are quite numerous but very shy and will try to avoid you. You are very unlikely to encounter one but should you see one then feel privileged.
